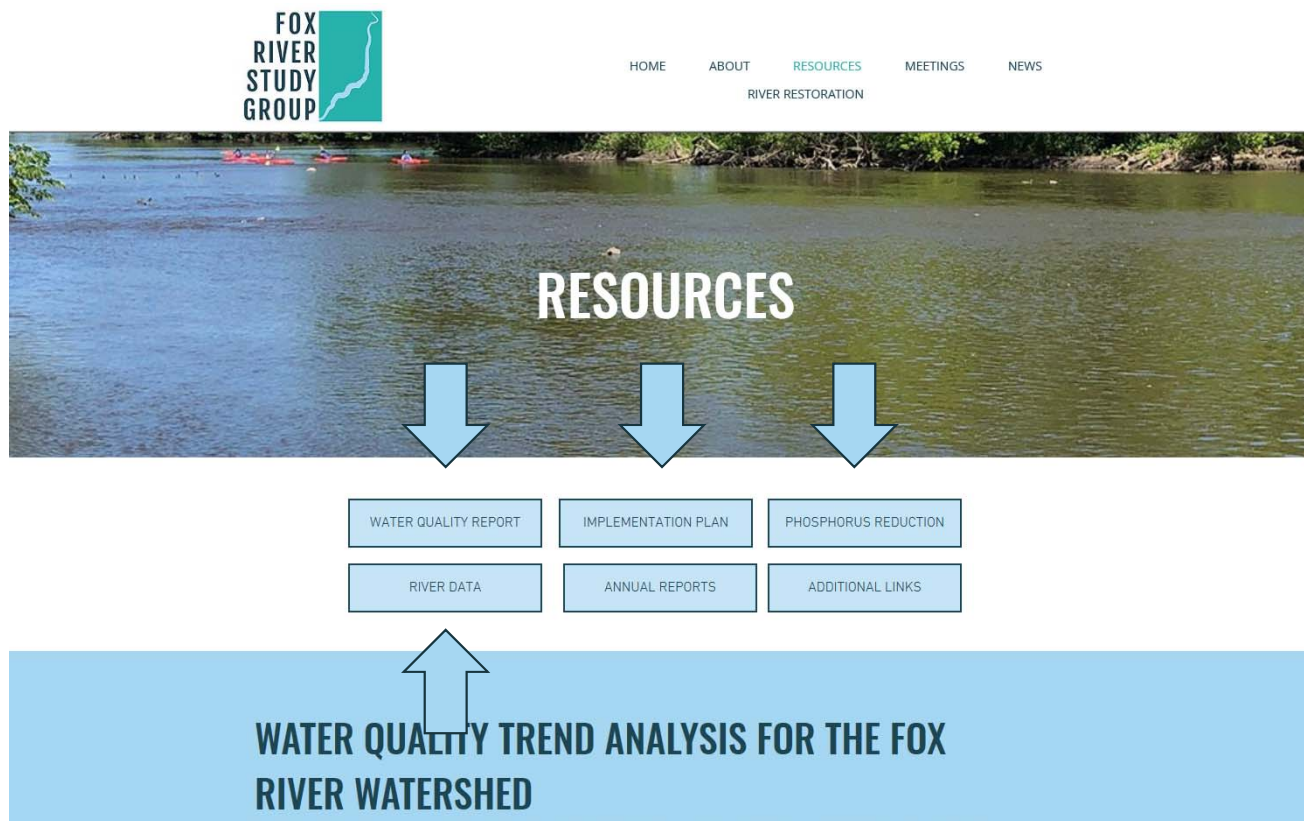
The mission of the Fox River Study Group is to enhance the health and vitality of our river for the benefit of the nearly 1 million citizens in the Fox River Valley.

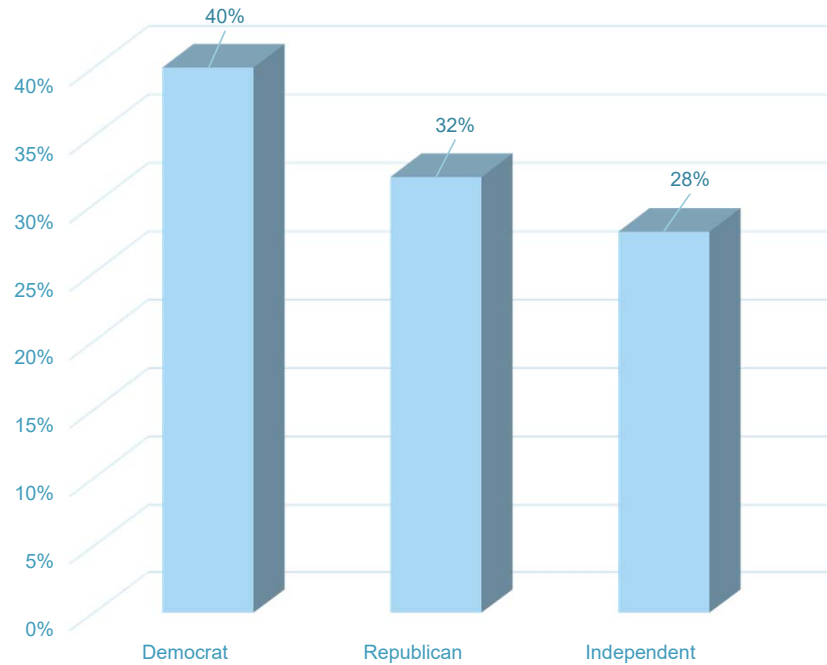

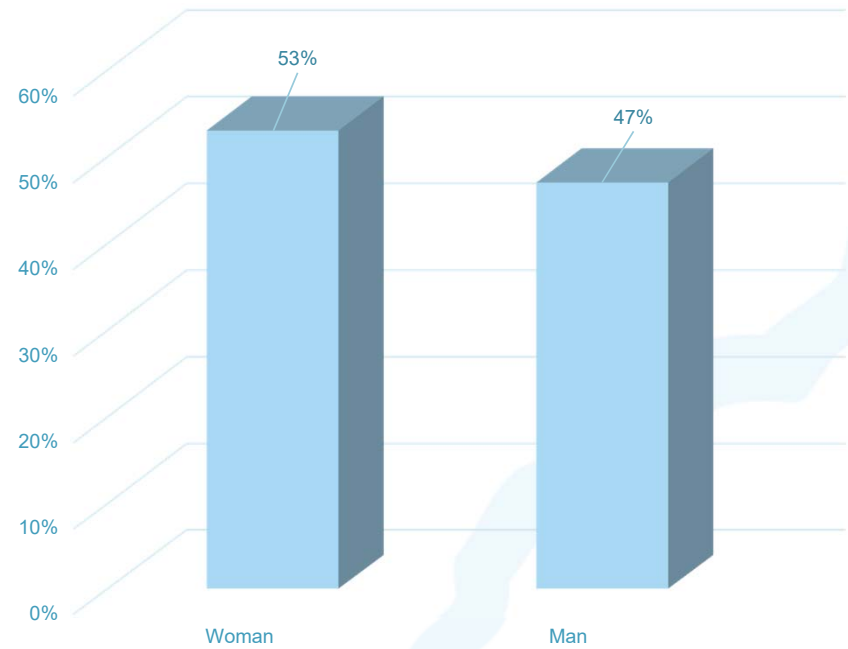


Phone Survey - Demographics

Political Affiliation

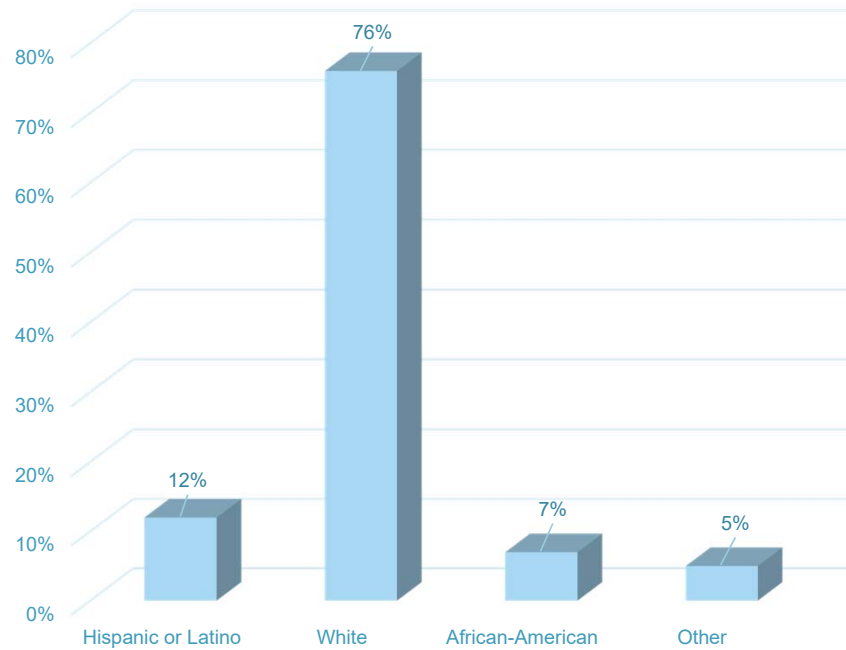


Gender

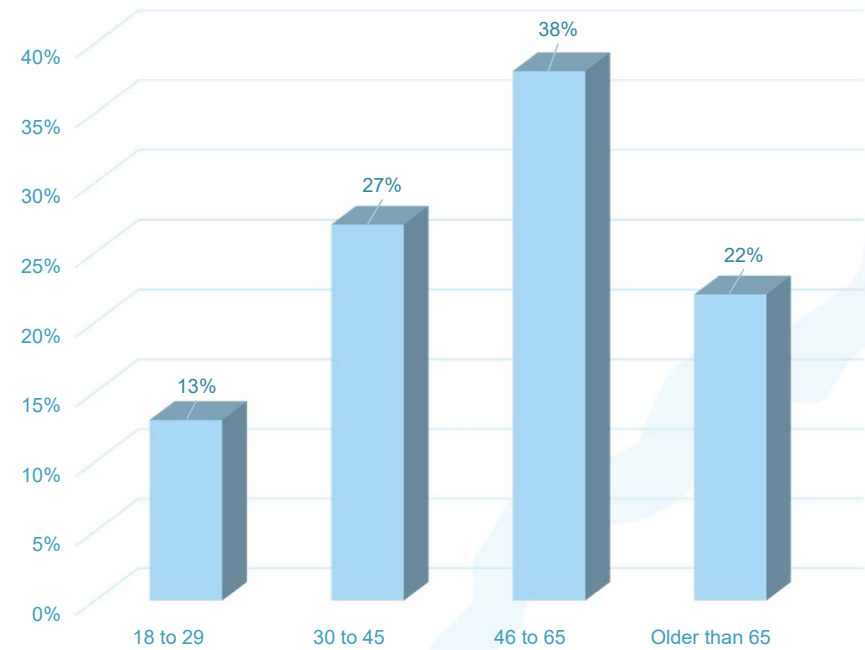

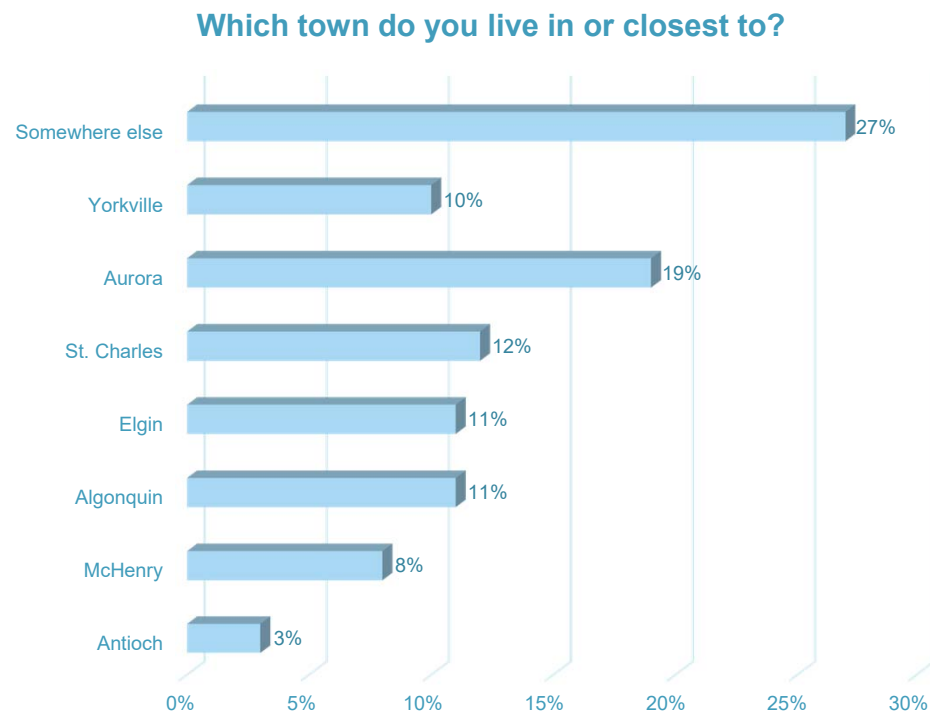
Race

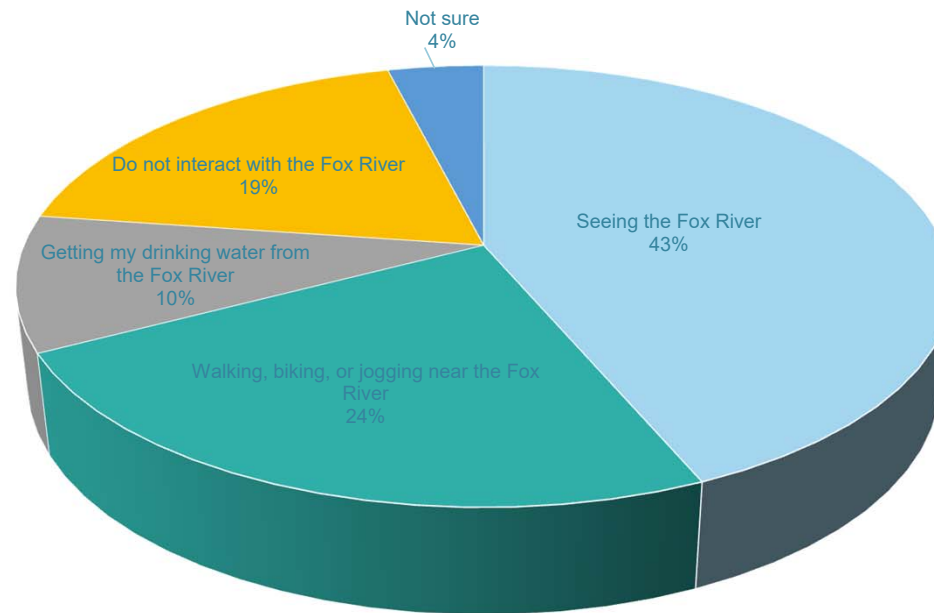

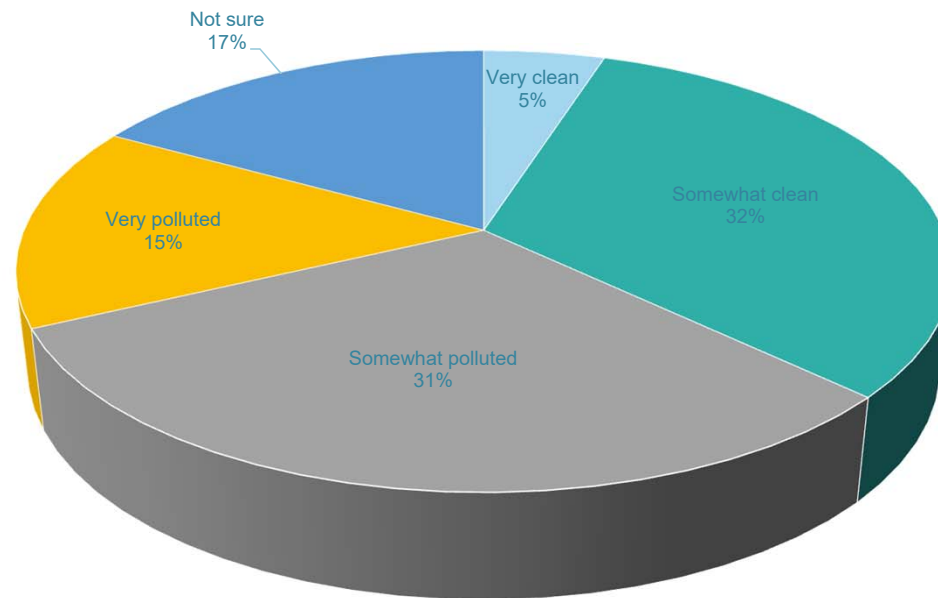
How do you most often interact with the Fox River?

Phone Survey - Results

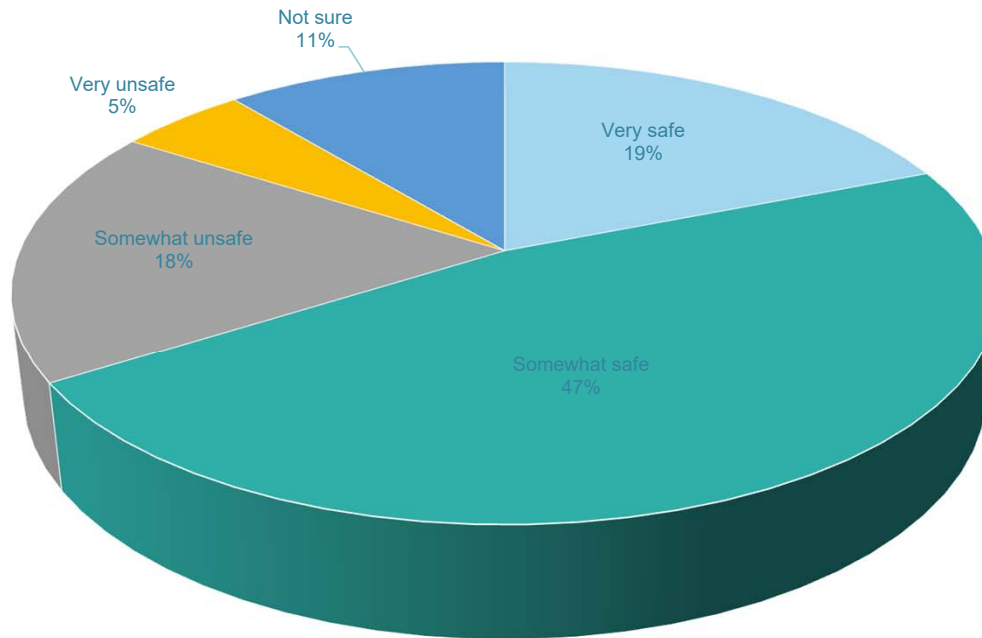
What do you think of the water quality in the Fox River?

Phone Survey - Results

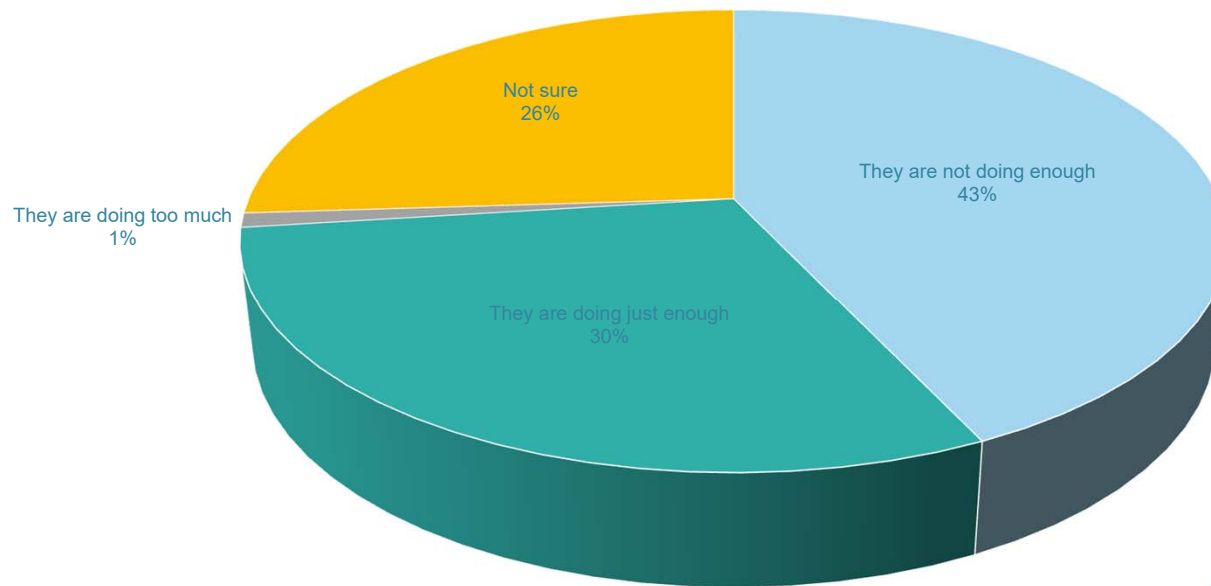
How safe do you think the Fox River is for paddling, fishing, or recreation?

Phone Survey - Results

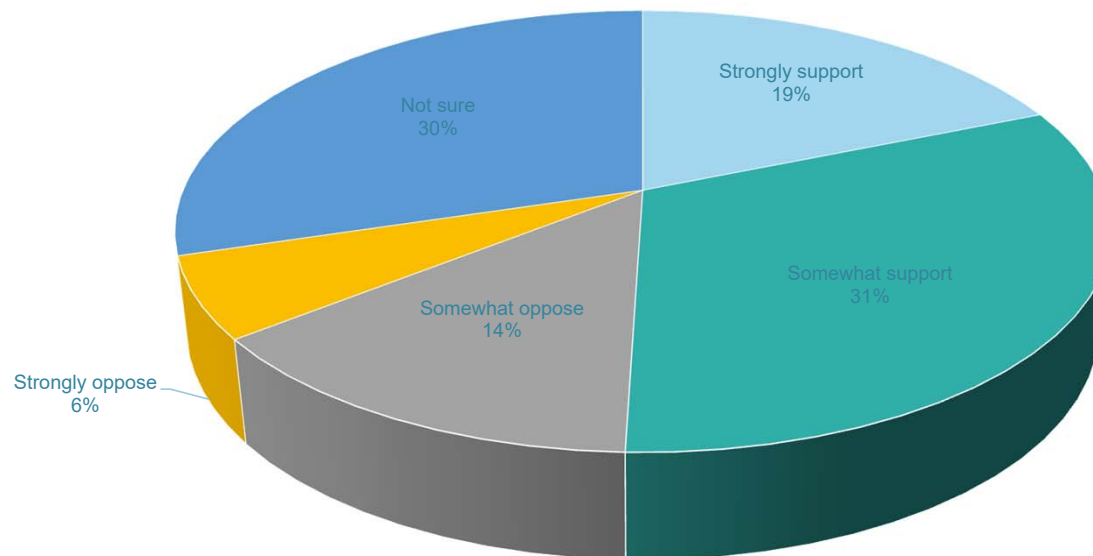
There are government agencies responsible for protecting the Fox River. Do you think...?
